Supernatural Supply

As Citizens of Heaven you never have to worry, God shall supply! He is the initiator, He is the One who has made a way for you. He is the One that is trying to get every blessing to you. This *supply* comes out of the mystery of Christ. Remember Paul states in Philippians 4:13:

"I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me."

This strength does not come to us out of the circumstances of life. The things that happen to us do not create strength within us. Most of the time it depletes us. But God's way is different! We are to draw strenath through Christ, through His Anointing! When things aren't going the way you want them to, what are you going to do? Give up? Get mad and blame God? No, Paul is saying that strength comes out of the Anointing of Christ. We need His strength to make it through all of the adverse and difficult circumstances of life! And His strength has nothing to do with what you may be going through. It is coming out of a completely different realm. How do we access this strength? Through the power of *giving*. Even in times of lack, the Philippian church chose to give. My friends, there is no lack of provision for you. God has and will continue to strengthen and bless you no matter what the outward may look like. As we begin, God will supply out of heaven, through Christ. It is this realm of heaven, this realm of anointing, this realm of faith, that God uses to bring His supply to us. Once you have experienced Him and have begun drawing from His source of strength, then you can apply verse 19 to your life:

"And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

Your supply is waiting for you in Christ Jesus! But what opens this supply to you? Not just giving, but living to give! Your identity changes and the image of Christ is stamped upon you. As it is written, "for God so loved that He gave", in like manner, "for I love so much I also must give!" Once you have tasted God's supernatural supply, what else is there? We won't settle for any substitute! God's supply is the only thing that truly satisfies and it is released to us through giving.
